Boone had extensive dental cleaning and teeth extraction while he was at AVHS. Dogs usually have 42 teeth. Boone had 14 missing when he arrived and we extracted another 15, leaving him with 13 teeth!

We had over 175 dental surgeries on shelter dogs and cats that need dental work when they arrived at the shelter last year. So many animals have dental disease by the time they are three years old, resulting in bad breath, painful chewing and tooth loss. With proper dental cleaning, to remove plaque and tartar, we are prolonging the lives of pets thus eliminating infection in the mouth and other organs.

We will perform additional dental surgeries for the adoptable animals at the shelter. We are thankful to have been able to accomplish what we have this year. We could not have done it without your help and we are honored to be here in your community, continuing our mission.
